





Students learn the points of Belief, Worship, and Character building through 5 themes: Muslim identity, Iman, `Ibadah, Halal and Haram, and Akhlaq. The We Are Muslims series is designed to nurture the holistic development of our young Muslims' spiritual life.

The Sirah and Hadith Program

Our Sirah program is more than a retelling of events in the Prophet's الميليني life. Aspects of his character and conduct are brought into focus and weaved into the historical account of Allah's final messenger الطلقي . These books encourage students to reflect on his life and to apply his moral character with engaging activities.

The Qur'anic Studies Program

Our Qur'anic Studies program provides opportunities for students to learn to decode and memorize the Arabic text of the Qur'an, as well as develop a clear understanding of the core message and teachings of the divine revelation. We also introduce students to the various sciences that deal with the study of Allah's sacred word.
